Starting January 2007, a 28 minute television program on Indonesia, titled **Gado-Gado Indonesia**, will be aired by various local TV cable channels in four different parts of the Washington DC Metropolitan areas.

The program is produced by the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in cooperation with Balak Satu Entertainment. Every month, both the Embassy and Balak Satu Entertainment will present different films for viewers to enjoy the various aspects of Indonesia life related among others to Culture, Music; Food, tourist destination; lifestyle etc.

"We would like to present the diversity of our country to the American people" says the Indonesian Ambassador to the United States, *H.E. Sudjadnan Parnohadiningrat*. "We also would like to show the face of modern day Indonesia" added *Ambassador Sudjadnan*.

The program can be seen once a week on Fairfax Public Access (FPA) Channel 10, channel 33 and channel 37; Arlington Independent Media (AIM) Channel 69; MHZ Networks which include Washington DC and MCT (Montgomery Community Television) Channel 19 and 20.

The first show can be seen on January 18, 2007 at 2pm on Channel 10 FCCA (Fairfax Public Access) and will be repeated according to the following schedule:
