On January 6, 2011, 10.00-11.00 pm EST, Indonesian Ambassador to the United States, Dr. Dino Patti Djalal, will participate as a speaker in a discussion with Indonesian Minister for Marine Affairs and Fishery, Fadel Muhammad, the U.S. Ambassador to Indonesia, Scot Marciel, Science Envoy of the White House, Dr. Bruce Alberts, and U.S. National Ocean and Atmospheric Administrator (NOAA) Administrator, Dr. Jane Lubchenco.
